

Italian network ReTe AIDS: telephone intervention based on counselling skills for the prevention of HIV and STIs

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Introduction/Summary

- ReTe AIDS is a network of Helpline services managed by public and non-governmental organizations in various Italian regions. It was established in 2008 and is coordinated by the UO RCF - Istituto Superiore di Sanità, including 13 Helplines which provide primary and secondary prevention activities in the area of HIV and STIs throughout the national territory.
- The main characteristics of the users who accessed the ReTe AIDS Helplines in 2023 are reported herein, with a focus on their attitude to testing, and on the most addressed areas dealt with during the telephone counselling interventions.

Study Design and Methods

- The ReTe AIDS Helplines share the communicative-relational method applied in the telephone intervention. It is structured according to the basic skills of counselling, with a rigorous methodological procedure.
- A common data-entry software allows to catalog and archive the data emerging from telephone interventions, in a completely anonymous form. Only data related to the gender, age and geographic area of the user are collected. Information on risky behaviors and other questions arisen during the intervention are collected based on standardized and shared classification criteria.
- A descriptive analysis of calls received during 2023 was performed collecting aggregate data from 13 Helplines by means of the Access 365 software.

Distribution of gender in users calling Helplines of ReTe AIDS




Results

- In the year 2023, 12,835 telephone calls were collected by the Helplines of the ReTe AIDS.
- Most calls (70.8%) arrived to Telefono Verde AIDS e IST of the Istituto Superiore di Sanità and 29.2% by the other Network Helplines. Most calls (63.0%) were the first ones by Helplines users, which were prevalently males (84.4%). The age ranges reported by users were mainly 25 – 29 years (19.6%), 30 – 34 years (17.8%), 35 – 39 years (14.6%).
- In 57.8% of the calls, the users reported heterosexual relations and in the 14.2% relations between men who have sex with men. The execution of the HIV test was reported in 58.6% of phone calls in consequence of risk behaviors, pregnancy, surgery or blood donation while In 24.1% of phone calls the test was never performed.
- In 2023, ReTe AIDS experts answered to 39,064 questions from users, focusing mainly on transmission ways of HIV and other STIs and on diagnostic procedures.

Conclusions

- ReTe AIDS can be considered a national observatory for the study of users' needs in the field of HIV and other STIs, with the possibility of reporting the specific requests that emerge during each counselling intervention.
- The AIDS ReTe is a powerful tool to raise awareness and disseminating strategic Health information, through the involvement of professionals providing solid and up-todate information, promoting effective prevention of STIs through healthy behaviors.
- The Network promotes the fight against the stigma and discrimination related to STIs, which is still very widespread in Italy, thus promoting a culture of inclusion and the promotion of testing for STIs.
